

## Processes: Final Meeting

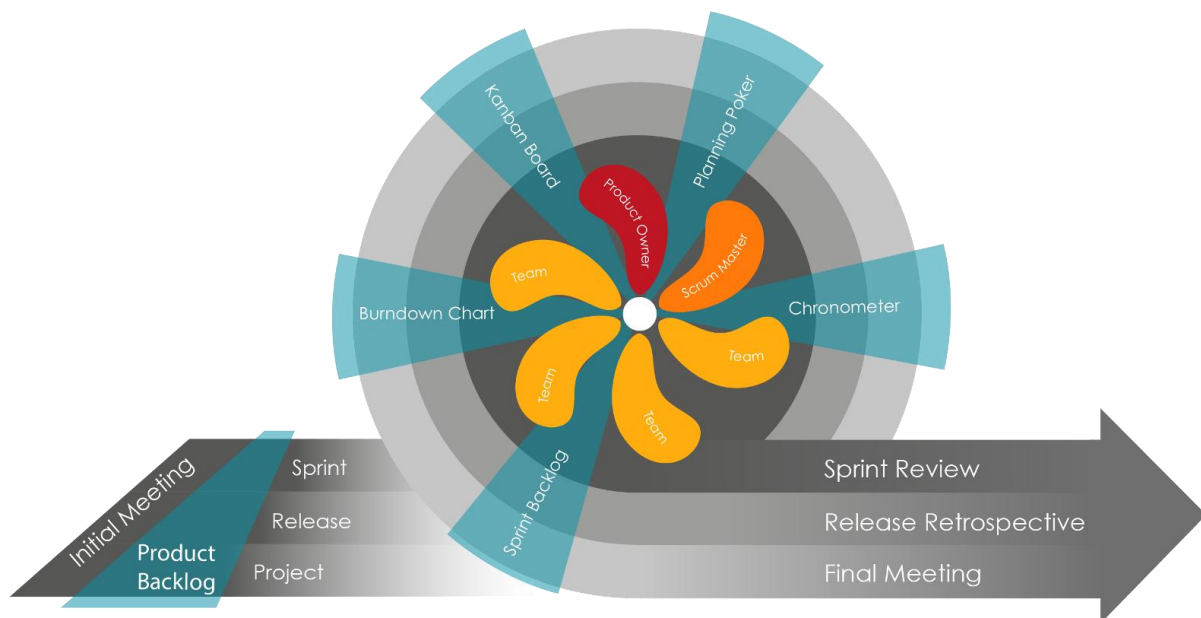
